

Downloading to an iPod & iPhone



iPhone

E-books are now available for download to the iPod touch and iPhone. All downloads take place through the device using the Wi-fi or 3G connection.

How to check out a book using an iPod or iPhone:

1. Download the free Overdrive Media Console App from the app store. When this is successfully downloaded, it will bring you to Adobe and ask you to create an account with them. Create an Adobe account with a valid username and password. *Write down this username and password— you will need it for your first eBook download.*
2. Open Safari Browser and go to NorthBabylonPL.org. Click on the “Downloadable Media” link.
3. Click on the “eBook” link and search by title, creator, ISBN, or browse the collection. Choose **Adobe EPUB** from the dropdown of the “All Formats” box. Click Go.
4. Once you have found a title you are interested in, make sure it is labeled “**EPUB Format.**”
5. On the screen you will see how many copies of the book are available at the moment. If available, add the book to your cart (be sure to click the “Add to My Cart” button next to the **Adobe EPUB eBook** heading), if unavailable you can add your name to the wait list and be emailed when it is available.
6. At this point, you will be told that the loan period is 7 days, and you have the option to continue browsing to add more items to your cart, or you may proceed to checkout.
7. When checking out, you will be asked for your home Library and barcode number.
8. At the next screen you can choose a lending period of 7 or 14 days. You will be told how many checkouts you currently have, and how many more you may checkout. (Patrons may only have a total of 5 eBooks checked out at a time.) Once a lending period has been selected, click “Confirm Checkout.”
9. On the next screen, select “Download.” *If this is your first time downloading an eBook to the iPod or iPhone, you will be asked for your Adobe username and password.*
10. Overdrive will automatically open and your book will be displayed.
