

Downloading to a nook

E-books are now available for download to the Barnes & Noble Nook. They can be read on any generation Nook. E-books may only be downloaded using a computer and USB cable; eBooks may not be downloaded directly from the device regardless of 3G or wireless capabilities.

How to check out a book for the Nook:

1. On your computer visit NorthBabylonPL.org, and click on the "Free Downloads" link.
2. From here, click on the "Software" link at the very bottom of the page and download OverDrive Media Console (for audiobooks) and Adobe Digital Editions (for eBooks). You may sync your Nook to five (5) different computers, but you must make sure that the Nook is authorized under the same Adobe Digital Editions id (email address) as the computer. Note that your ID will be the same for each computer that you install the software on, so write the ID and keep it in a safe place for reference.
3. Once these items are properly installed, connect the device to the computer using the USB cable that came with the Nook.
4. Return to Live-brary.com (through the "Free Downloads" link on our homepage). Here you can do a simple search with the title, author, or keyword, or you may choose to perform an advanced search.
5. Once you have found a title you are interested in, make sure there is an icon of a book in the upper right corner (headphones means it is an audiobook). Click on the book cover and make sure that "**Adobe PDF or Adobe EPUB.**" is listed under "Available Formats."
6. On the screen you will see how many copies of the book are available at the moment. If available, click "Borrow." If the book is unavailable, you can add your name to the wait list and be emailed when it becomes available by clicking "Place a Hold."
7. When checking out, you will be asked for your home Library and barcode number.
8. You will be brought back to the screen with the "Borrow" button. Click this button again to access your download. Next, click the "Go to Bookshelf" button. You can read the book in the browser by clicking "Read" or transfer it to your nook by selecting "EPUB" or "Adobe PDF" from the "Other Format(s)" dropdown menu, then choosing "Confirm"
9. At this point, Adobe Digital Editions will automatically open and you should see your download. ***If you do not see the book cover, you can use the "Library" button on the top left of Adobe Digital Editions to bring up all of the books that have been downloaded to the program. If you still do not see the book, select "all items" or "borrowed" from the menu on the left side of the screen.*
10. Click on the book cover and, holding the button on the mouse, drag the book cover to the picture of the Nook on the left side of the screen. Once the book is aligned with the Nook icon, release the button on the mouse.
11. When you have transferred all books to the Nook, go to the left side of the screen and select the Nook icon to eject the device. You may remove the USB cable and begin to enjoy your eBook!
