North Babylon Public Library Parking Lot

The Library's parking lot is expressly for patrons using the library and for library staff while at work. The parking lot may not be used for any other activity, without consent, in writing, in advance, by the Board of Trustees and/or Library Director. Any other use will not be permitted.

Parking is only permitted in marked spaces. The responsibility of finding a legal parking space rests upon the vehicle operator. Yellow curbing or striping indicates no parking zones. There is no parking along the south driveway or in the loading zone. Parking is prohibited on the grass or on the sidewalk. Local, state, and federal laws apply to vehicles parked in the Library's parking lot.

No overnight parking. Disabled vehicles may not be left in the Library's parking lot overnight.

Unregistered, unlicensed or uninspected vehicles are not permitted in the Library's parking lot. Commercial vehicles, other than of patrons using the library or contractors working on Library premises are not permitted in the Library's parking lot.

The Library takes no responsibility for damage to personal vehicles or property while on the Library premises. Lock your vehicle.

Vehicles parked in the Library's parking lot illegally or improperly will be towed at the owner's expense. The Library takes no responsibility for damage to vehicles while being lifted, towed, or stored, etc.

When patrons use the Library's parking facilities, the following should be kept in mind:

- o The parking lot is expressly for the use of patrons using the library.
- o Parking is only permitted in marked spaces.
- o We are in a residential neighborhood monitor your alarms, horns and radios.
- o Do not block handicap cut-outs, entrances, exits or the alleyway.
- o Be careful when you back up; avoid an accident.

The Library's parking lot is expressly for patrons using the library and for library staff while at work.

All other vehicles in the Library's parking lot will be towed and stored at the owner's expense.
