General library rules apply in the Quiet/Study Room.

Use of the Quiet/Study Room is reserved for patrons who require a distraction-free workspace.

Silence is expected.

Single use only.

North Babylon Public Library cardholders only.

Users must be 16 years of age or older.

First-come, first-served; no reservations accepted.

Two hours in the Quiet/Study Room per day, extendable at the discretion of the librarian.

The Quiet/Study Room must be vacated 15 minutes before closing; 7:45PM, weekdays, 4:45 PM, Saturday and Sunday.

The Quiet/Study Room left vacant for more than 15 minutes will be assigned to another user.

Consumption of beverages, alcoholic beverages, food, smoking, vaping, etc. are prohibited.

The Quiet/Study Room is not intended for private business activities. Soliciting any person for the purchase of goods/services, or engaging in activity involving payment for goods/services, is strictly prohibited. Paid or unpaid tutoring is prohibited.

Phones are not permitted.

Sleeping is not permitted.

The library is not responsible for personal belongings left inside the room.

Please use the room responsibly and be mindful of those who will be using the room after you.
