What is it?

100 Books Before Graduation is a reading challenge for teens to read 100 books before they graduate from high school. Studies have shown reading for enjoyment has a positive impact both academically and socially.

Who Can I Participate?

All participants must have a valid North Babylon Library Card and must currently be in grades 6-12.

How Does it Work?

Scan the QR codes below to register and then to log the books you read along the way. We will keep track of the books for you. You will receive a certificate and prizes for every 10-book milestone. Bring your certificate to the Reference desk at the library to claim your prize.

There is no set list of books to read for this reading challenge. We just ask that you read books that are appropriate for you at your reading level. Fiction, nonfiction, graphic novels, audiobooks, ebooks all count.

Check out our book recommendation flyers in our teen area or chose to get personalized reading suggestions when you sign up. If you choose to get librarian recommendations our librarian will email you some titles you may like based on your previous reads.

You have until your school's graduation day of your senior year to complete the program.
