

Sex Offenders

Notification and Dissemination of Information Regarding Sex Offenders in the Community

The Suffolk County Police Department, or other departments, may send notification to the North Babylon Public Library when a sex offender is to be released to a residence within the North Babylon School District, commonly referred to as "Megan's Law." The Library may receive notification including: name, address, class of offender, crime of conviction, photograph, modus operandi, type of victim, special conditions imposed, etc.

Upon receipt of sex offender documentation, the Library Director will relay information received by the Library to all pertinent Library individuals deemed by the Director to be in a position to appropriately utilize such information. The Library is free to maintain or not maintain any such notification/documentation.
